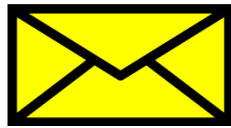

## GENERAL INFORMATION



These are ASCA sanctioned shows and all ASCA rules apply ([www.asca.org](http://www.asca.org)). Dogs over 6 months of age must have proof of ASCA registration available. CASA, the Course Director and club members assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by any exhibitor, handler, dog, property, children or spectator. All dogs must be crated or leashed except while competing.

Entry fees will not be returned if the trials cannot be opened or be completed due to riots, civil disturbances, acts of God, public emergencies or other events beyond the control of CASA. Entry fees will not be refunded if the dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by the Show Committee, ASCA, show veterinarian or the judge.

All entries must be on the official ASCA entry form with proper fees included. Exhibitors are responsible for the accuracy of the entry and the class entered. Withdrawal of entries will be accepted until the pre-entry closing date.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and there will be a \$35.00 service fee on all returned checks. Entry into future shows/trials and participation in this show/trial will not be allowed until all fees are paid in cash or money order.

**Information:** Substitutions are allowed providing the dog is owned by same owner. Draw for run order will be after trial registration closes. Bitches in heat will run in order of draw, but must be crated and exercised away from the competition. Overflow judges may be hired and the limit of runs per day as well as judging assignments may change. All breeds recognized by ASCA as herding breeds are eligible to enter the trial.

Stock to be used: 5 head ducks per run, 3-5 head per run of wool and/or hair sheep and 3-5 head per run of 300 to 800# black angus or mixed calves. Owners of dogs will be responsible for all injuries to livestock; replacement cost per Call duck is \$75; Rouen/Runner cross duck is \$25; per sheep is \$500; per cow is current market value.

Limit of 60 stock runs per TRIAL not to exceed: Sheep (20 run limit), Cattle (20 run limit), & Ducks (20 run limit) Based on entries, the above listed limits may change and judging assignments may change.

*Classes Offered for Cattle/Sheep/Ducks: Started, Open, Advanced, Novice, Working Jr. Handler, Open Jr. Handler*

If need be Trial 2 ducks will begin shortly after Trial 1 cattle starts in order to complete everything in a timely fashion. You are responsible to be on site for your runs. Any changes will be posted at the Trial Registration Desk in advance of the Trial starting.

*An overflow judge will be hired if entries merit.*

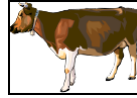
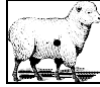
