## **GENERAL INFORMATION:**

- No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA Conformation program; a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs; or a person not in good standing with ASCA.
- Entry fees will not be returned if the show cannot be opened or be completed due to riots, civil disturbances, acts of God, public emergencies or other events beyond the control of CASA. Entry fees will not be refunded if the dog(s) is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by the Show Committee, ASCA, show veterinarian or the judge.
- **ENTRIES:** Payment in full must accompany entries and be made in US funds. CASA will not run a tab for entries. Telephone, facsimile or incomplete entries will not be accepted. All entries **MUST** be on the enclosed entry form(s) with proper fees included. Exhibitors are responsible for the accuracy of the entry and the class entered. Withdrawals of entries will be accepted until the pre-entry closing date listed; thereafter, no refunds will be made. Signature required for mailed entries **WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED**. No class changes will be allowed once entries have closed on the day of show or trial.
- Any check returned to CASA's bank invalidate all entries associated with that check. Writer of the check will be required to pay a \$50 administrative fee, in addition to all bank charges associated with the returned check. Entry into future shows/trials and participation at this show/trial will not be allowed until all fees are paid in cash or money order. If the issue is not resolved within 10 days, the writer of said check will be reported to ASCA.
- Dogs over 6 months of age must have proof of ASCA registration available. All dogs' ages will be calculated as of day of show. Be prepared to present papers on all dogs six months of age or older.
- Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of ASCA rules and regulations.
- **DOG/PUPPY SALES ARE NOT ALLOWED.** Any person found to be selling dogs on the premises will be asked to leave. Puppies under the age of 2 months prohibited from the show grounds. Puppies/dogs over the age of 16 weeks are required to have proof of rabies vaccination.
- **CASA, ASCA and Messer Event Center** assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers or to any of their dogs, personal property and/or children. Children are to be supervised at all times.
- **Any handler, owner or spectator being abusive towards a dog, exhibiting poor sportsmanship and/or not picking up their dog's poop, will be asked to leave the show site for the duration of the show weekend and/or the show will be stopped so that cleanup after dogs can be completed.**
- Access to the building will be at 12 noon on Friday, October 16, 2020 and open at 7am on Saturday & Sunday, October 17 & 18, 2020. Building will be closed and locked each evening. No dogs may be left in the show building overnight.
- Shows will be held indoors in a heated arena on packed dirt.
- Concessions will be onsite and restaurants and convenience stores are nearby.

## COVID-19 INFORMATION

- All attendees **MUST** wear a face covering while inside the arena (while competing, during briefings, etc.)
- Everyone in attendance will be expected to maintain social distancing of at least 6 feet both in and out of the show ring. Individual set ups must be spaced a minimum of 6 feet apart.
- Spectators or individuals not directly involved in the showing of dogs each day should be kept to a minimum.
- All entry forms must be completed prior to coming to the entry table. CASA will provide extra entry forms at a table located away from the entry secretary. Please ensure you bring a pen if entries need to be completed at the show.
- All exhibitors and spectators are expected to act in a responsible manner with regard to social distancing, sanitizing of hands, and wearing appropriate face covering as outlined above. While hand sanitizer will be provided by CASA for judges, stewards, and volunteers, all exhibitors and spectators should bring their own hand sanitizer in the event that extra is not available.
- Judges will not be handing out any ribbons. Ribbons can be picked up from the show secretary or ring steward. Remember, ribbons will not be mailed.
- CASA, along with Messer Event Center, its management and employees, reserve the right to request anyone behaving in a reckless or inconsiderate manner with respect to COVID-19 to leave the grounds. If this becomes necessary, no refund of entries will be made.
- If you forget your face coverings, CASA will have disposable masks available at \$1.00 each.
- If you are sick, exhibiting Covid-19 symptoms, or have recently been exposed to someone who tested positive for Covid-19, we ask you to stay home. CASA reserves the right to excuse anyone who is showing signs of illness.

**EXHIBITOR/OWNER OR PARENT/LEGAL GUARDIAN (IF JR IS UNDER 18) MUST READ AND SIGN THIS FORM**

**IMPORTANT LEGAL AGREEMENT**—(1) The person signing this Agreement represents being authorized to enter into it on behalf of him/herself, as well as (if different) the owner(s) and handler(s) of the dog(s) for which an entry form is being submitted (all these parties collectively referred to herein as “Applicant”). (2) “Releasees” here collectively refers to the Australian Shepherd Club of America® (ASCA®); its officers and board of directors, staff, contractors, insurers, attorneys, and agents; as well as ASCA®’s affiliate clubs and each of their members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees, judges, contractors, insurers, and agents. (3) Applicant enters into this Agreement in consideration for being allowed to submit an entry form and, if approved, to take part in related activities of ASCA® and/or its affiliates. (4) Applicant acknowledges entering into this Agreement voluntarily, after the opportunity to obtain independent legal review of it and to have questions about its likely meaning answered through such review. (5) Applicant accepts the terms of this Agreement not only on his/her own behalf but also for his/her successors, assigns, beneficiaries, heirs, parents/guardians, and anyone else who might raise a claim on his/her behalf or as a result of her suffering harm. (6) To the extent any provision or application of this Agreement turns out to be unenforceable, the rest of it still remains fully effective. (7) This Agreement is to be interpreted under Texas law, without application of its choice-of-law rules, and—to the extent permitted by law—any legal action by Applicant that names Releasees as one or more defendants shall be filed and heard solely in the state or federal courts serving the county of ASCA®’s headquarters: Brazos County, Texas. (8) Applicant agrees to abide by the rules and regulations of ASCA® and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event. (9) Applicant represents that the dog(s) being entered is/are not known to pose a hazard to persons, other dogs, or property and that all required rabies and other vaccinations under the state and local law of the dog’s state of residence are current. (10) Applicant acknowledges awareness of and assumes the risk associated with his/her participation and that of his/her dog(s) in this event and related activities, among which are personal injury to Applicant and those affiliated with Applicant, injury to Applicant’s dog(s), and damage to Applicant’s property. As but a few examples, Applicant and/or his/her dog(s) may be injured from the condition of (or failure to warn of the condition of) floors, stairways, lighting, security measures or a lack of them, electrical devices, fittings, show rings, parking areas, motor vehicles, and unfamiliar animals and people. (11) Applicant releases Releasees from any claim or liability whatsoever arising from any injury, harm, liability, or demand in anyway said to occur during or in connection with related events, also waiving any right to assert such claims that he/she otherwise might have in the absence of this Agreement. (12) Applicant also agrees to indemnify Releasees from any claim that Applicant or those acting on Applicant’s behalf, for Applicant’s benefit, or in Applicant’s place, might assert against Releasees. The obligation in this regard extends even to Applicant’s paying settlements, judgments, and expenses and costs of legal defense incurred by Releasees. (13) The waivers, releases, and promises of indemnification undertaken by Applicant in this Agreement EXTEND EVEN TO: CLAIMS ASSERTING NEGLIGENCE PER SE, CONDUCT THAT IS INTENTIONAL OR RECKLESS, CLAIMS OF FRAUD, CLAIMS INVOLVING DEATH, ACTIVITY THAT WOULD OVERLAP WITH ALLEGATIONS OF CRIMINALITY, AND/OR CLAIMS SEEKING EXEMPLARY DAMAGES. They apply without regard to the basis of the claim (e.g., based on tort, breach of contract, common law, implied or express warranty, or otherwise). Applicant’s promised indemnification of Releasees also extends to claims third parties assert against Releasees said to be based on Applicant’s conduct. (14) INFECTIOUS DISEASE—Applicant’s promises and assumption of risks in this Agreement also extend to the risk and any asserted harm Applicant and the dog(s) may suffer from actual or threatened exposure to infectious disease, whether COVID-19 or otherwise, and Applicant accepts full responsibility for taking such measures as may be required or prudent to protect Applicant and well as other participants in the events. Applicant represents being aware of related recommend health practices, e.g., masking and distancing. (15) Applicant assigns to ASCA® the sole right to pursue any claim in connection with or arising in relation to the scheduled events that Applicant or those acting for Applicant otherwise might assert against any person or entity affiliated with ASCA®. (16) There are no provisions to this Agreement other than as spelled out here and they may not be modified except by formal ASCA® board action. This Agreement is to be interpreted to provide Releasees with the maximum protection from liability allowable under the law.
