Check-In & Measuring: 7:30 am; Handlers Meeting: 7:45 am; First Dog On The Line: 8:00 am Entries and Changes: Incomplete or inaccurate forms or entries submitted prior to the Opening Date of June 20, 2022, will **NOT** be accepted. If you use an overnight courier, check the box "*Signature Waived*". The Entry Clerk and/or Trial Secretary will not sign for entries. Requests for changes or move-ups to your entry must be received in writing or email to the Entry Clerk by July 22, 2022. Day to day move-ups will be accepted by the trial secretary if requested before the class begins. FEO entries will be accepted for the Championship Program. Dogs entering FEO must be a minimum of 15 months of age. FEO entries may jump at a lower height, but are not eligible for any prizes or awards. Any dog under 18 months must jump at a lower height. FEO is a non-qualifying division.

Pre-Entry Fees: 1-9 Runs - \$16.00/Run (Junior Handlers are 1/2 price of entry fees)
10-19 Runs - \$14.00/Run
20+ Runs - \$10.00/Run

Pre-Entry pricing includes all dogs in your household that are competing in this trial

Post Entry Fee (July 23, 2022 After): \$20.00 per run. No quantity run discount. (If runs are available)

Refunds: A 100% refund will be given for any request received prior to the close of pre-entries. There will be no refund of any entry fee for cancellation requests made after trial closing date

Catalogs/Run Orders: No catalogs will be printed. Run orders will be posted at the gates on trial days. Handlers with multiple dogs will be separated as much as the class allows. **Handlers with toys will run in class order according to jump height.**

Measuring: Dogs entering the jump height classes 20" or less (with height less than or equal to 20"), that do not have a permanent ASCA, AKC or NADAC height card **must** be measured. Dogs entering 20+" or 24" jump heights (include ACE/Veteran/Jr. Handler division dogs entered in the 16+" jump height classes) are exempt. **Please send in a copy of your Height Card with your entry if you have one. If you do not have a height card, the Jump Height card application is attached to this premium. Please have two copies of this application filled out, your dog can be measured by the judge at the trial. There will be two judges available at this trial to measure your dog. Jump Height card applications should be submitted to the trial secretary who will send in the applications with the completed trial paperwork to the ASCA Business Office.**

Titles: Dogs must be registered with ASCA to have their titles tracked with ASCA. You may enter as "pending", but need to complete a Q tracking number form. You may send in your completed registration forms along with the appropriate fees to the ASCA Business Office prior to the trial or give to the trial secretary at the trial to send in with completed trial paperwork to the ASCA Business Office. CASA is not responsible for lost Qs if you do not register with ASCA in a timely manner. You may enter without a tracking number; you just won't be getting your Q's recorded with ASCA. If you have any questions about obtaining an ASCA Q tracking number, send an email to agility@asca.org. Forms are included in this premium, or can be downloaded from www.asca.org/Forms. Titles can be earned under one judge. Twenty points are required for jumpers and gamblers; thirty points are required for regular.

Ribbons: first thru fourth place ribbons will be awarded for each jump height in all classes & levels. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded for each qualifying run. High In Trial rosettes will be awarded to Novice, Open, Elite for the Championship program; Junior Handler and Veteran Dog. High In Trial Rescue Dog. High In Trial Overall Championship Program and High In Trial Overall ACE Program. Ribbons will be calculated using the formula outlined in Section 2.6.2 of the ASCA Agility Rulebook. **If you could finish an ATCH during this trial, please inform the Trial Secretary before the Trial. Please mark on the entry form if your dog is a Rescue Dog.**

HIT Ribbons will be awarded on Sunday after completion of trial & teardown of rings. Ribbons MUST be picked up the day(s) of the trial. CASA will NOT mail any ribbons.

****NEW FOR 2022**** CASA will have a random draw for prizes each trial day. 3 winners will be randomly selected from all entries received for each trial day. Drawing will take place at the handlers meeting each morning. To be eligible for this drawing, exhibitors must be entered in the trial for each day prior to the handlers meeting.

Trial Site & Equipment Information: The trial will be one ring, 110' x 100' indoors on sand/dirt mix. Equipment may include the following: Dog walk (slatless), A-frame (slatless), teeter-totter, tunnels, weave poles (24" spacing), non-winged & winged jumps. Contacts are rubber coated. A-Frame will be set at 5'6". Electronic timing will be used at this event.

Policies & Rules:

This trial will be held according to ASCA Agility rules. Exhibitors, through submission of their entry, acknowledge that they are

knowledgeable of ASCA rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial. The ASCA Agility Rulebook is available for viewing or download at: www.asca.org.

- ASCA, CASA, and Latigo Trails Equestrian Center will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor.
- All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when using the warm up area or in the agility ring. No dogs may be tied to any piece of property. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and control of his/her owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the trial premises.
- No leads, collars, food, toys, clickers or other aids or devices will be allowed on the course or within 10 feet of the ring entrance at any time. The only exception to this is leading your dog to the start line on lead and then handing the lead to a steward.
- The handlers should always conduct themselves in a sportsmanlike fashion.
- No entry will be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA agility program; a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs or a member not in good standing with ASCA.
- There will be no refunds in the event that a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for the dismissal.
- Safety shall always be the foremost consideration in actions and conduct by handlers at all times.
- Participation is a privilege afforded by the Host club and may be extended or withdrawn by the Host club on suitable cause only. Refusal of such entries will be reported to ASCA.
- **COVID-19: The most current covid-19 rules will be followed. Face coverings may or may not be required, please be prepared. It is extremely important that all exhibitors use preventative measures. CASA will make every effort to make this trial safe.**

AGREEMENT

IMPORTANT LEGAL AGREEMENT—Please read the following carefully as it, among other things, may prevent you from suing ASCA® and persons/entities affiliated with it. This agreement could even require you to defend them from demands and suits by third parties that include an assertion of wrongdoing by you. (1) The person signing this Agreement represents being authorized to enter into it on behalf of him/herself, as well as (if different) the owner(s)/exhibitor(s)/handler(s) of the dog(s) for which an entry form is being submitted (all these parties collectively referred to herein as "Applicant"). (2) "Releasees" here collectively refers to the Australian Shepherd Club of America® (ASCA®); its affiliate clubs; and the officers and board of directors, staff, contractors, insurers, attorneys, and agents of ASCA® and of those clubs. (3) This Agreement voluntarily is entered into by Applicant in exchange for the acceptance of the associated entry form and permission to participate in related activities. (4) Applicant agrees to abide by the rules and regulations of ASCA® and any other rules and regulations applicable to this event. (5) Applicant certifies that the entered dog will not pose a hazard to people, property, stock animals, or other dogs, and further that the dog is current with rabies shots along with any other vaccinations required by its state of residence. (6) Applicant acknowledges and assumes the risks to Applicant and Applicant's dog associated with participation in the event, among which could be ones associated with poor condition of the facilities and surrounding areas; security measures or lack of them; electrical appliances; fittings; show rings; the presence of unfamiliar persons; and the presence/involvement of other animals—whether stock, dogs, or otherwise. (7) Applicant further agrees to comply with all recommended and required health and safety precautions, among which may be those related to social distancing; quarantining; wearing of face coverings; and non-participation of persons exhibiting symptoms or for whom there otherwise has been a likelihood of recent exposure to COVID-19 or other contagious diseases. (8) Applicant additionally acknowledges and agrees to assume the risks associated with taking part in the event though others might neglect compliance with health and safety precautions/requirements or pose an undue risk of spreading disease. For example, as is true as to any public event, there is some risk that Applicant and/or those affiliated with Applicant may catch COVID-19 or another contagious disease at the event. (9) To the maximum extent permissible, this release is to be interpreted under Texas law, without application of its choice of law rules. (10) To the extent that Applicant—or another party suing on behalf of Applicant, or suing to recover based on injuries/death/damage to Applicant/Applicant's dog/Applicant's property—sues ASCA® (or a board member or staff member or agent of ASCA®) as a defendant, the sole appropriate forum (to the maximum extent permitted by law) for the suit shall be the state or federal courts serving Brazos County, Texas (where ASCA® has its headquarters). (11) Applicant hereby releases and waives any claims Applicant otherwise might assert against the Releasees as to any injury or damage claim connected in any way to any alleged act or omission arising out of, or occurring concurrent with, the event and related activities, interactions, communications, and even adjacent premises. (12) This release is made not only as to Applicant but also for anyone who might assert a claim on behalf of Applicant or based on purported injury or damage to Applicant/Applicant's dog/Applicant's property, as well as any heir, beneficiary, assignee, executor, trustee, agent, or survivor of Applicant. (13) Applicant further agrees to assume sole responsibility for and indemnify and hold Releasees harmless from related claims, demands, judgments, and settlement payments. (14) These waiver, release, and indemnification provisions extend even to claims or demands asserting that the acts or omissions resulted in bodily injury or death or from intentional wrongdoing, as well as to attorney fees and other costs of defense. (15) The duties of indemnification further extend to any claims or demands asserted against Releasees that are alleged to have arisen out of the acts or omissions of Applicant, Applicant's dog, or others affiliated with Applicant. Among other things, this means that Applicant would pay the legal defense of Releasees if someone sued them based on a claim Applicant carelessly exposed the claimant to COVID-19. (16) Applicant's promises in this agreement apply without regard to the type of claim or cause of action asserted against Releasees. (17) To the extent any provision of this agreement is unenforceable, the remainder of it nonetheless is to be enforced. (18) This agreement is to be interpreted to provide Releasees with the maximum permissible legal protection from—among other things—claims and suits pursued by Applicant (and/or those acting on behalf of Applicant or over injury/damage to Applicant), as well as from ones based on the purported wrongful acts or omissions of Applicant. (19) Nothing in this Agreement requires you to indemnify Releasees from claims by third parties that involve no allegations of improper acts or omissions by you, those affiliated with you, nor your dog(s). (20) Applicant acknowledges having read, understood, and had the opportunity for independent legal review of this document prior to signing it.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is the total cost for a QT number?

The cost for membership (required) is **\$20 per owner** if not already a current member.

- Membership expires in one year and only needs to be renewed if applying for another dog after membership has expired.
- Owners will need to renew their membership each year to keep track of dog's scores/titles in the online member portal. To sign up for an online account, please visit www.asca.org and click "Register" under Member Login (must have member ID#).

Membership fee in addition to the QT number fee of **\$20 per dog**.

A QT number is good for the lifetime of the dog and will not expire.

For one dog with one owner, the total cost is **\$40**. For two dogs with one owner, the total cost would be **\$60**. For one dog with two owners, the total cost would be **\$60**. (This is assuming no owners are current members or under 18).

Do I have to have a QT number to compete?

- You do not need a QT number to compete in ASCA Agility, Stockdog or Dock Jumping events, unless you want to earn ASCA titles.
- You must have a QT number to compete in ASCA Obedience, Rally and Tracking Tests.

Why would I need or want a QT number for my dog?

To have ASCA keep track of your scores and receive title certificates for your accomplishments.
